- In October of 2017, our family's life changed forever with a **diagnosis of ALS for my brother David**
- David was a normal healthy guy in his late 40's, working hard, racing cars, and raising two wonderful kids
- **The average life expectancy is 2-5 years**
- **ALS is currently incurable** and it manifests itself differently for everyone; but we know that ALS isn't incurable, it is just underfunded

- Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis is a disease that gradually paralyzes the body's muscles

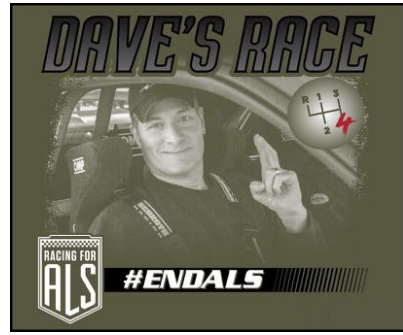

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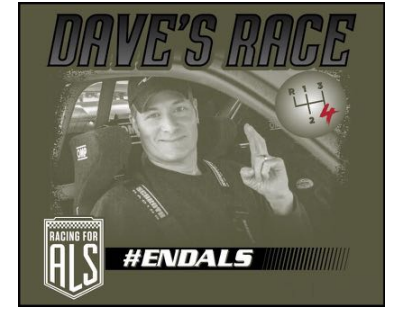
